- Japan's largest investment bank, established in 1925

- Approx. 30 markets, 20 exchange memberships & 10 CCP links

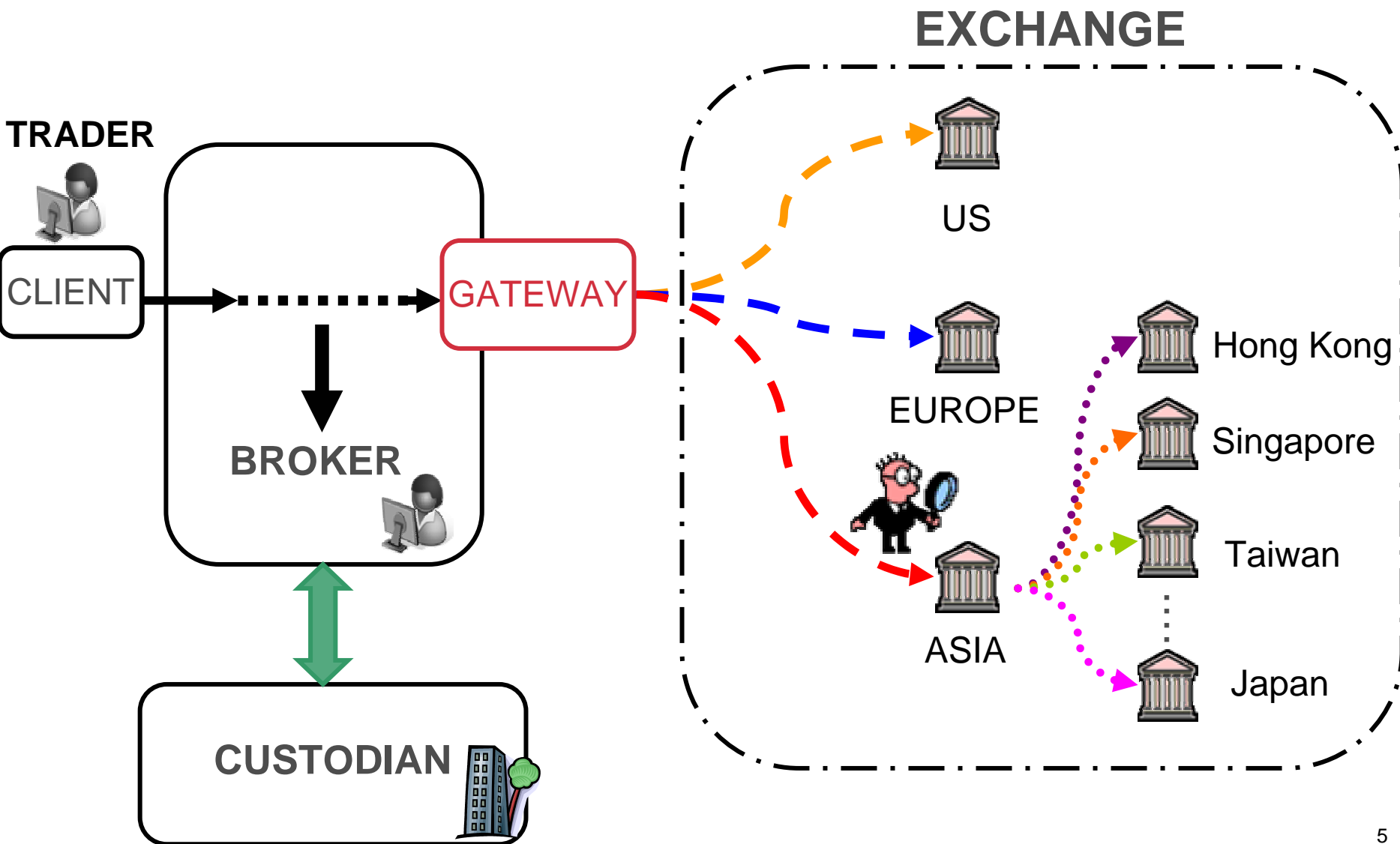
SWIFT / SSC / ISSA

- SWIFT (Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunication s.c.r.l) : As of 2007/12
 - Approx. 3.5 billion messages, 8332 users, 208 countries
 - Average 13.9 million messages per day
 - Overall growth of approx. 22%
- SSC (Swift Securities Committee) : As of 2008/2
 - Securities messages growth p.a. up approx.30%
 - Securities messages distribution approx. 40%
- ISSA (International Securities Service Association)
 - 95 members in 47 countries : As of 2007/7

The Global Standardisation of SWIFT Messages

- Standards for Securities - Pre-XML Era
 - 1970s: Financial Industry creates SWIFT
 - 1980s: ISO/TC68/SC4 defines ISO7775
 - 1984-97: ISO7775 deployed on SWIFT
 - 1992: Financial Information eXchange (FIX)
 - 1994-1999: ISO/TC68/SC4 defines ISO15022
- Standards for Securities – XML Era
 - 2002: ISO15022 Migration started. MT103 migration completed
 - 2003: ISO15022 Migration completed
 - 2004: ISO20022 Plan published and to be completed by 2013(??)
